




### CHARLES DARWIN Panorama Lounge Bar

### **QUITO & GUAYAQUIL AIRPORT**

 Free shuttle service in connection with the cruises. Pick up time from hotels to airport: approx. 3 hours before the flight, from/to specific hotels in Quito and Guayaguil. Reservation is required.

Pick-up items will be reconfirmed at the hotel the night before the departure.
